A Closer Look at Food Insecurity in Minnesota


Here's a county-by-county look at the percent change in food shelf visits in 2023 vs. 2022. The chart shows those counties with the greatest increases in food shelf visits. Benton County saw a 99.8% jump in visits from 2022.


